

## **DISCIPLINARY POLICY**

The following procedure for the administration of discipline is as follows:

The Dean of Student, in conjunction with Disciplinary Committee, is responsible for all disciplinary matters relating to student. However, a student reserves the right to appeal against any disciplinary decision taken against him/her.

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## **DRESS CODE**

Instructional staff of the Ruth Ramstrand School of Nursing are required to be dressed in their laboratory coats during clinical instruction and student are to wear the appropriate uniform during clinical instructions and also during clinical practices at the Hospital.

Administrative & Faculty staff of the College are encouraged to dress in African or European attire. No collar T-shirt and shower slippers are permitted on college campus.

## **INFRINGEMENT OF THE RIGHTS OF OTHERS OR ASSAULTS & USE OF PROVOCATIVE LANGUAGE**

Any student caught in the habit shall be investigated and if found guilty, penalty shall range from warning, suspension to expulsion.
